



Morris Technology Information



Below you will find some important information as we move forward during the next three weeks and prepare for distance learning. Lessons will be provided using a program called Edgenuity in Odysseyware. Access to a computer and internet will be needed. The online curriculum plan contains learning resources and activities that are meant to engage your child academically while we are learning from a distance.

- This is the platform where PISD has loaded your student's academic lessons.
- The platform can be found and accessed through the district website.
- Teachers will share instructions with students for how to communicate needs for support. These virtual meetings will take place through email, meeting in Google Meets virtual meetings, and/or Zoom.
- This platform is linear; student will complete lessons in order, one at a time.
- There will be a timeline/scope and sequence and dates for students to follow.
- Assignments will consist of multiple choice quizzes and writing projects. Multiple choice quizzes are graded automatically and teachers will grade writing projects in stages as they write according to a rubric. Teachers will enter a weekly grade in Skyward.
- There is the capability to provide feedback on assignments and teachers will monitor how much time is spent on assignments and quizzes.
- Morris teacher office hours are scheduled for 9:00-11:00 am and then 1:00-3:00 pm.
- The plan is for students to be able to log in Monday, March 23rd. Students will be prompted to watch a tutorial video on how to operate the system. It is user friendly.
